AMYA 36/600 Class Rules

(Validated July 2000)

• HULL

- 1. Length Maximum hull of 36 inches.
- 2. Prohibited
 - 1. Movable keels
 - 2. Center boards, lee boards, bilge boards
 - 3. Bowsprits
 - 4. Overhanging rudder
 - 5. Movable or shifting ballast
 - 6. Outriggers, pontoons
 - 7. Twin hulls, tunnel hulls
 - 8. Changing rudder, or keel weight during a series of races
 - a. Rudder may be changed if there is undisputable damage only -- (1988)
- SAIL
 - 1. SAIL AREA
 - 1. Maximum of 600 square inches -- (AMYA formula)
 - 2. Roach limit 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches, main and jib -- (1982)
 - 2. SPINNAKERS Allowed and unmeasured, provided spinnaker is independent of all other sails.
- DESIGNATIONS
 - 1. Sail designations are to be placed in the upper third of the mainsail. Numbers are to be no less than one inch in height.
 - 2. Sail designations will be the number 36 with a bar under it, and the registration number placed below the bar.
- SAIL REGISTRATION
 - 1. Numbers must be no less than a minimum of three (3) inches overall.
