NOTICE OF RACE-AMENDED (in red fonts below)

- DATE:** DF65 Saturday, February 25, 2023
DF95 Sunday, February 26, 2023
- RULES:** The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, as modified by Appendix E, Notice of Race, Sailing Instructions, the Dragon Force 65 and Dragon Flite 95 Restricted Class Rules, and subject to local COVID regulations. In case of conflict, the SI's will prevail.
- If the lead boat arrives at the *zone* of the first windward mark without previously completing at least two non-penalty tacks to windward, the race shall be abandoned.
- ELIGIBILITY:** The Florida Travelers Trophy is open to all boats of record with the DF65 and DF95 Class and members of the AMYA or applicable International RC Associations.
- VENUES:** The primary venue is North Collier Regional Park (NCRP), 15000 Livingston Road. Depending on wind direction, an alternate pond adjacent to Dick's Sporting Goods, 5955 Naples Blvd, might be used. Emails and texts will be sent to registered sailors no later than Noon the day prior if the alternate pond will be used.

- ENTRY:** The regatta will be limited to 36 boats per Class. Eligible boats may be entered by using the online entry form or completing the attached entry form and mailing it so as to be received 10 days prior to the regatta with an entry fee of \$22 for one day or \$44 for both Saturday and Sunday. Breakfast, lunch, and drinks will be provided both days. Awards will be given to the top three competitors in each Class.

- HOUSING: Limited free local housing in NMYC members' homes is available on a first come, first served basis. Registered sailors should contact Treasurer.NMYC@gmail.com to reserve a spot. Alternately, a list of nearby local motels is available on NMYC's website in the [2023 Regatta Schedule](#) section.
- SCORING: The regatta will be scored using the Low Point Scoring system as set forth in Appendix A of the RRS. If there are more than 20 competitors in either Class, races will be run under the P/R Race management system. One discard to be awarded for every 4, 8, and 16 heats sailed.
